Sergeant Sandy Tomeo began her police career with the Plano Police Department on February 13, 1989. As an officer, she served in a variety of capacities including field training officer, undercover narcotics officer, and as an investigator in the Professional Standards Unit. She was promoted to the rank of sergeant in August of 1999; she transferred to the Family Violence Unit in 2003. In 2005 she transferred to the Crimes Against Persons and Sex Crimes Unit where she is currently assigned as the supervisor. Sgt. Tomeo has been assigned to the crisis negotiation team both as an officer and as a sergeant. She obtained her basic negotiation training from the San Antonio Police Department in November 1997. Additionally, she has trained at the Timberlawn Psychiatric Hospital, Dallas Police Department as well as receiving training hosted by the F.B.I and the Baltimore County

Detective Brian Pfahning has worked for Plano PD for 9 years and currently works in the Crimes Against Persons Unit as a Detective. He has been part of the Crisis Negotiator Team for 6 years. He has received training in Basic and Advanced Hostage Negotiations as well as numerous classes in Police Crisis Negotiations. He has extensive experience in working with the Suicide and Crisis Center and over 13 years of paramedic experience including working with persons suffering from mental illness.
